This page gives some information about new mineral findings in Norway. It is not complete, and will never be. Some are rumors, other are confirmed findings.

- 11/2 Silver crystals was recently found at Vinoren silver mines north of Kongsberg. The size is up to 7 mm. Together with the crystals, cm large aggregates of thin wiry silver was found.
- Several pockets with quite nice calcite was found just before Christmas in the Bjønndalen quarry.
- 14/2- 50 cm large anhedral calcite crystals is found at Eide, Nordmore. Some of the crystals is twins, and part of the inside of the crystals have optical quality. Smaller, transparent twins was also found.

17/3- Strontiodresserite have been found in a marble quarry in Nord-Salten by Tomas Andersen. This is the first locality in Norway and probably the second in the world. The mineral was identified with XRD and XRF.

26/4- A 2,5 x 1,5 cm large thalenite crystal was recently found at Hundholmen.

2/5- A new norwegian locality for perrierite was found recently at Urstad, Hidra. The subhedral, up to 5 cm long, metamict crystals was identified by heating and XRD at MGM. Up to 10 cm long, metamict gadolinite crystals and up to 2 cm long, elongated crystals of the zircon variety malacon was also found.
